Bubbler, LLC ("Bubbler," "we," "our," or "us") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal information.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, store, share, and protect information when you access or use the Bubbler, LLC mobile application, website, and related services (collectively, the "Service").

By accessing or using the Service, you agree to the collection, use, disclosure, and processing of information as described in this Privacy Policy.

1. Information We Collect

Information You Provide

We may collect information that you voluntarily provide, including:

- First and last name
- Email address
- Phone number
- Mailing address
- City, state, province, ZIP/postal code, and country
- Profile information
- Social media profile information when using social login providers
- Photos, images, screenshots, and media you upload
- Comments, annotations, messages, and communications
- Account preferences
- Customer support communications
- Subscription and purchase information

Information Collected Automatically

When you use the Service, we may automatically collect:

- IP address
- Device identifiers

- Operating system
- Browser type

2. Mobile Device Permissions

Depending on the features you use, Bubbler, LLC may request permission to access certain device features.

Camera and Photos

We may access your camera and photo library to allow you to:

- Capture images
- Upload photos
- Share media
- Annotate visual content

Location Information

We may collect location information, including GPS data, to provide location-based features and improve the Service.

Contacts

If permitted by you, Bubbler, LLC may access your device contacts to facilitate invitations, collaboration features, and user connections.

You may revoke any permission through your device settings at any time. Some features may not function properly if permissions are disabled.

3. How We Use Information

We may use information to:

- Provide and operate the Service
- Create and manage user accounts
- Enable collaboration and communication features
- Display and organize uploaded content

- Authenticate users
 - Process subscriptions and purchases
 - Improve functionality and performance
 - Conduct analytics and research
 - Personalize user experiences

4. User Content

You retain ownership of your content.

By submitting content to the Service, you grant Bubbler, LLC a limited license to host, store, display, process, and transmit such content solely for the purpose of operating and improving the Service.

5. Analytics and Tracking Technologies

We may use analytics, monitoring, advertising, and diagnostic technologies to:

Understand how users interact with the Service

- Measure advertising effectiveness
- Develop new functionality

Analytics and tracking technologies may collect information such as device identifiers, advertising identifiers, session activity, usage patterns, location information, and performance data.

Mixpanel

We use Mixpanel, an analytics service provided by Mixpanel, Inc., to help us understand how users engage with the Service. Mixpanel may collect and process information such as device identifiers, advertising identifiers, IP addresses, session activity, event data, usage patterns, and other interaction data. This information is used to analyze user behavior, improve the Service, and develop new features.

Mixpanel processes data in accordance with its own Privacy Policy, which can be reviewed at <https://mixpanel.com/legal/privacy-policy>. You may opt out of Mixpanel's data collection by visiting <https://mixpanel.com/optout> or by adjusting your device's advertising settings.

Bubbler, LLC does not sell data collected through Mixpanel to third parties. Data collected through Mixpanel is retained in accordance with Mixpanel's data retention policies and our internal data governance practices.

6. Email Communications

We may send communications including:

- Marketing communications where permitted by law

You may opt out of promotional emails using the unsubscribe instructions included in those communications.

Operational, security, and account-related communications may still be sent when necessary.

7. Payments and Subscriptions

Apple App Store Purchases

Subscriptions purchased through Apple's App Store are governed by Apple's payment systems and billing policies. Subscriptions automatically renew unless canceled before the end of the applicable billing period. You may manage or cancel subscriptions through your Apple account settings. Bubbler, LLC does not directly store complete payment card information processed by Apple.

Google Play Purchases

Subscriptions purchased through the Google Play Store are governed by Google's payment systems and billing policies. Subscriptions automatically renew unless canceled at least 24 hours before the end of the current billing period. You may manage or cancel your subscription at any time through your Google Play account settings or the Google Play app. Bubbler, LLC does not directly store complete payment card information processed by Google.

General Payment Terms

Except where required by applicable law, all payments are non-refundable. Refund requests for purchases made through Apple's App Store or Google Play Store are subject to the respective platform's refund policies, and Bubbler, LLC has no control over refund decisions made by those platforms. Pricing is subject to change with reasonable notice, and continued use of the Service after a price change constitutes acceptance of the new pricing.

8. Sharing and Disclosure of Information

We may disclose, share, transfer, or otherwise make available personal information to third parties for business, operational, advertising, marketing, analytics, and commercial purposes.

9. Advertising and Remarketing

Bubbler, LLC may display advertisements within the Service.

Advertisements may be provided directly by Google, Bubbler, LLC or through third-party advertising partners.

We retain information:

- To enforce agreements
- For backup and disaster recovery purposes

Retention periods vary depending on the type of information and applicable legal requirements.

13. Security

We implement reasonable administrative, technical, and organizational safeguards designed to protect information from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

Despite these efforts, no security system is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

Users should exercise discretion when sharing sensitive information through the Service.

14. Your Privacy Rights

16. California Online Privacy Protection Act Notice

17. Children's Privacy

The Service is not directed to children under the age of 13.

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13.

If we learn that we have collected information from a child under 13, we will take reasonable steps to delete it.

18. Acceptable Use and User Content Rules

Users are responsible for all content they upload, create, share, annotate, transmit, or otherwise make available through the Service.

Users may not upload, share, or distribute content that:

- Violates applicable laws

Bubbler is not obligated to remove content solely because it is reported but will evaluate reports in good faith based on applicable laws, platform requirements, and community safety considerations.

20. DMCA Copyright Policy

Bubbler respects the intellectual property rights of others.

If you believe content available through the Service infringes your copyright, you may submit a copyright notice containing:

- A description of the copyrighted work
- Identification of the allegedly infringing content
- Your contact information
- A good-faith statement regarding unauthorized use

Upon receipt of a valid notice, Bubbler may remove or disable access to the allegedly infringing material.

- Contact information
- Consent to the jurisdiction of the appropriate court
- A physical or electronic signature

Bubbler may restore content where appropriate and in accordance with applicable law.
